

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners.

One of the greatest lessons to be learned in life is to realize information is not wisdom. It's what we do with information that leads us to gain wisdom. It is knowledge that gives us the good sense to ask a question. Wisdom is the sensitivity to perceive the truth. But there's more to it all than all this. Wisdom is more than mere information and knowledge. Why? Because wisdom is not always reasonable. Sometimes wisdom appears to be downright foolish, like turning the other cheek, praying for one's enemies, forgiving those who hurt us, and overcoming evil with good instead of vengeance. Wisdom is more than simply having experience in living. Please don't misunderstand – experience is important, but we need more.

So where do we find this wisdom? We are aware it comes from God, but is it unattainable – beyond our reach? No, it is quite attainable. God is present to us, even to the youngest of children. You and I know children who are very wise. We also know people lacking in formal education who are considered very wise. Wisdom is not an act, a science or a technique. Wisdom is an answer to a problem. If we spend our whole lives, merely solving problems, processing data, and managing information, we risk missing the whole purpose of life. Life is not a problem to be solved. Life is a mystery to be lived.

To live in wisdom you must reflect, you must contemplate. You must look at life lovingly and longingly. You must look into the hearts and souls of those around you. You must discover the Creator in all who are made in God's image and likeness. You must find the face of God in their faces, and God's love in their love. If you understand this, then you are not far from attaining true wisdom.



This is the wisdom we hear about today in our first reading from the book of Proverbs which suggests a route of God's Wisdom. For this Wisdom was next to God from the very beginning. Wisdom discovers and then experiences God in that which He has created, and comes to see the image and likeness of God in all of those around us.

Hopefully on this feast of the Trinity we will attain a better understanding of the Trinity of Three Persons in One God. When we relate with love to those persons who surround us with their love, we are closer to understanding the simplicity of God's love. Let us pray for that Wisdom which can only come from God, that we might, one day, be called wise in the ways of the Lord.

First Reading: *Proverbs 8:22-31* God created Wisdom before He created the earth or the skies. This spirit stood beside God every day until the earth was complete, then "found delight in the people of the earth." This indicates that the spirit of wisdom was later personified by Jesus.

Responsorial Psalm: 8:4-9 O Lord, our God, how wonderful Your name in all the earth!

Second Reading: *Romans 5:1-5* Paul says that we are now at peace with God through our faith in Jesus. We also hope to see the glory of God. This hope will not leave us disappointed because of the love God has shown in sending us the Holy Spirit.

Gospel: *John 16:12-15* Jesus tells the disciples that when He leaves them, a Spirit will help guide them to the truth. This Spirit will announce what He hears from Jesus, rather than speaking on His own. Everything God has also belongs to Jesus, which is why those things announced by the Spirit will actually come from Jesus.

Family Connection

Think of the last time you witnessed an act of selfless love in your family. Parents and care givers of all kinds are called upon to act selflessly every day. Family life calls us to share selfless love with one another.

God is the model for us of selfless love. There was no need for God to create our planet or the creatures that inhabit it; it was an act of selfless love. There was also no need for God to send His only Son to save us. That too was an act of selfless love.

As we draw closer to God and the mystery of the Trinity, we learn about God's love. God has lavished us with love in the persons of the Son and the Spirit, who in turn nurture in us the desire to do the same. When we open ourselves to be filled with an awareness of the divine life within us, we participate in the endless spiral of love that leads to eternal life. Whenever we share selfless love in the family, we are sharing in the life of the Trinity.



BAPTISM INSTRUCTION SESSIONS: Parents and Godparents must attend Pre-Jordan Sacramental Preparation before the Baptism takes place. Prior to attendance, parents are required to pre-register those attending the session by contacting the Parish Center Office, 215-855-1311. Although instruction sessions are mandatory for both Parents and Godparents, you are required to attend one time only. If you have attended previously you are not required to come again. Ideally, attendance at the preparation session should occur before the child's birth. Upcoming sessions are scheduled in the RE Room (in the church), at 7:00 PM on the 3rd Monday of the month: i.e. June 17th, July 15th.

REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS

must be a registered member of a Catholic Parish and receive a Certificate of Eligibility* from that Parish and have attended the Pre-Jordan Baptism class

→ must have completed his/her 16th birthday

- must have been Baptized Confirmed and has received First Holy Communion and actively practicing their faith e.g., attending Mass, receiving Holy Communion receiving the Sacrament of Penance
- → if married must be living in a valid sacramental marriage
- → cannot be the parent of the child to be baptized
 → the godparents are to be one male and one female
- → one godparent may be a non-Catholic Christian witness with proper proof of his/her baptism — if a non-Catholic is asked to be a Christian witness - the other godparent MUST be Catholic
- → a person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason, may not be asked to carry out this responsibility

Please note: The paperwork for the child's baptism and certificates of eligibility* MUST be completed at least two weeks prior to scheduling a baptism date. Certificates of eligibility must have a parish seal and cannot be faxed; they must be the original.

*CERTIFICATES OF ELIGIBILITY: A certificate of eligibility is asking for a priest to sign and acknowledge that the person is 16 years of age or more, confirmed and married in the Catholic Church and celebrating the sacraments regularly. This person must be registered and an active member of the parish for at least six (6) months.

Baptism is administered at 12:30 PM EVERY SUNDAY.
