

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

Have you tried to listen to someone who spoke in a whisper in a crowded room? If you have, you know how carefully you had to listen. Maybe you found it impossible to understand the conversation when there was noise in the background. The first reading today reminds us that God often speaks to us in unexpected ways. If our lives are so full that our minds are cluttered with thoughts and feelings clamoring for our attention, we may miss the Lord speaking to us. Listening attentively is essential for our spiritual growth.



Most of us have learned to tune out or ignore many of life's noises when we are not deliberately paying attention to them. Unfortunately, we often develop a pattern of not listening. But, if we desire to be attentive to God we need to set aside the time to be with God. Listening requires not only that we hear the words of Scripture, but that we also pay attention to what is happening within us as we listen. This becomes a process of spiritual awareness. Are we drawn to God by what we hear or do we turn away? Does what we hear bring us joy or make us fearful?

Do you ever feel that you are being called to walk on the waters – to face your own fears? What risk is God inviting you to take? These are only two of the possible questions that you could ask yourself after hearing today's gospel. Perhaps you had no question, but have become more aware of how difficult it is to really listen, to listen not only with your ears but also with your heart. Learning to listen is a process; it takes time.

By reflecting regularly on our lives, we can learn to listen when God speaks to us. For example what is it that brought joy into your life on any given day? What were the things that caused distress in your life, and how did you converse with God about these things? Prayer will give you the opportunity to disengage yourself from the noise and clutter of your life and come before God in the silence of your heart. When you give yourself over to God, you will discover that God is everywhere – within yourself, in the beauty of nature, in the people we meet, and in all your experiences of life. Listen – do you hear God?

PARISH REGISTRATION

Often people attend Mass at Corpus Christi Church for several years, but do not register with the parish. Others delay registering until they are asked to be a godparent or Confirmation sponsor, would like to have their own child baptized, or would like to schedule a wedding or a funeral at the parish. Registering in a parish is a declaration of your desire to be part of a Catholic community. If you are not currently a member of our parish and live within the parish boundaries, we invite you to consider registering with us and making a commitment to the life of Corpus Christi Church. Register at the Parish Center Office, Monday-Friday, from 9am to 5pm or give us a call at 215-855-1311 between those hours if unable to visit in person.

We now offer our parishioners Electronic Giving as a method of making regular monthly offerings to our church. The way this is

done is that you would make your monthly offerings by way of direct payments (ACH debits) from your checking/savings account on the 20th of each month (unless on a weekend or holiday in which case it will be deducted on the next business day).

You will continue to receive envelopes which will include special second collections as well as Christmas and Easter. The weekly envelopes will allow you to mark that you have chosen the electronic method for your offerings to Corpus Christi. First Reading: 1 Kings 19:9a, 11-13a After fleeing from the revenge of the King of Israel, Elijah hid in a cave, but at the command of God, he went outside and stood on a mountain. There the Lord came to him, not in the wind nor in the earthquake, but in a "tiny whispering sound."

Responsorial Psalm: PS 85:9, 10, 11-12, 13-14 R. (8) Lord, let us see Your kindness, and grant us Your salvation.

Second Reading: Romans 9:1-5 Paul is deeply pained because the Jews - in spite of everything that has been given to them - have rejected Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 14:22-33 Matthew vividly recounts the event of Jesus walking on the water. When the disciples see this, they are terrified, and Jesus chastises them for their fear. Peter begs Christ to let him walk on the water; he is at first brave but begins to sink and loses faith, crying out, "Lord save me!" Christ rescues him for his faltering faith.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

"Then the Lord said to him. 'Go outside and stand on the mountain before the Lord, the Lord will be passing by.' A strong heavy wind was rending the mountains and crushing rocks before the Lord - but the Lord was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake – but the Lord was not in the earthquake. After the earthquake there was fire but the Lord was not in the fire. After the fire there was a tiny whispering sound. When he heard this, Elijah hid his face in his cloak...' 'Lord, if it is You command me to come to You on the water'. He said 'Come.""

Last week we were Peter, James and John for the Transfiguration. We return to the mountain today with Elijah. The Lord wishes to reveal Himself to us again. Where shall we find Him. The natural disasters of hurricane's, earthquakes and wild fires show power and cause great devastation. Perhaps such events force us to call out to the Lord in desperation.

God's presence was revealed in the tiny whispering sound, teaching us to listen closely, sense His presence and like Peter ask – if it is You bid me to come. The call of the Lord is constant and consistent. We need to seek a quiet silence to hear Him. The noises of blasting car radios, or construction equipment become a hindrance for us to hear Him speak. The psalmist urges us 'Be still and know that I am God.' Do you hear Him speaking?

BAPTISM INSTRUCTION SESSIONS: Parents and Godparents must attend Pre-Jordan Sacramental Preparation before the Baptism takes place. Prior to attendance, parents are required to pre-register those attending the session by contacting the Parish Center Office 215-855-1311. Although instruction sessions are mandatory for both Parents and Godparents, you are required to attend one time only. If you have attended previously you are not required to come again. Ideally, attendance at the preparation session should occur before the child's birth. Upcoming sessions are scheduled at 7:00 PM RE Room (in the church) on the 3rd Monday of the month i.e. August 21st, September 18th...

REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS

- must be a registered member of a Catholic Parish and receive a Certificate of Eligibility from that Parish and have attended the Pre-Jordan Baptism class
- → must have completed his/her 16th birthday
- must have been Baptized Confirmed received First Holy Communion and *actively* practicing their faith e.g., attending Mass, receiving Holy Communion receiving the Sacrament of Penance
- → if married must be living in a valid sacramental marriage
- → cannot be the parent of the child to be baptized
- → the godparents are to be one male and one female
- one godparent may be a non-Catholic Christian witness with proper proof of his/her baptism if a non-Catholic is asked to be a Christian witness the other godparent MUST be Catholic
- → a person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason, may not be asked to carry out this responsibility

Please note: The paperwork for the child's baptism and certificates of eligibility* MUST be completed at least two weeks prior to scheduling a baptism date. Certificates of eligibility must have a parish seal and cannot be faxed; they must be the original.

**CERTIFICATES OF ELIGIBILITY: A certificate of eligibility is asking for a priest to sign and acknowledge that the person is 16 years of age or more, confirmed (and if married marriage took place in the Catholic Church) and celebrating the sacraments regularly. Ideally, this person should be registered and an active member of the parish for at least six (6) months.

Baptism is administered at 12:30 PM almost EVERY SUNDAY.

Confessions: Saturday after 7:15AM Mass 3:15PM – 4:00PM, and also upon request at the Parish House.

DAILY PRAYER CHAPEL OPEN: Visits to the Blessed Sacrament during the day may be made in the Church Chapel. The Chapel is open every day from 7:45AM to 3:30PM except Wednesday when it is open until 6:30PM. Please enter the Chapel using the entrance walk on the side of the Parish House facing Supplee Road.

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION WEDNESDAYS



Eucharistic Adoration is scheduled every **Wednesday, from 7:45 AM til 6:30 PM** in the Church Chapel. Benediction is at 6:30 PM. (Novena devotions immediately following). REGISTRATION: Our diocese requires that all Catholics should be registered in the parish of their residence. If you have moved into our parish and have not registered with us, it is important that you call the Parish Center Office (215-855-1311) and make arrangements to do so as soon as possible. Certificates of Eligibility to act as a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation, **cannot be issued** unless you are already (preferably for 6 months) registered with us. **Please be aware that young adults over 21 (25 if in college) should register separately.**
