PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

Life is filled with occasions, great and small, which we desire to share with others; a walk on a nice day, a family wedding, playing a game together or sharing a birthday or special anniversary. At these times we may extend an invitation to family or friends to be with us for awhile. We invite others into our lives because we have a strong need to build and strengthen relationships and grow in love and intimacy with each other. It is our very experience of human intimacy which provides a reference point for our relationship with God. Without a human context for love, we will be hard-pressed to find intimacy with God. Today's Scripture readings aid us in our understanding of God's unending invitation for us to be one with Him.

Today's reading from the Book of Proverbs describes God's invitation to intimacy which is continually echoed throughout the Bible: come, eat, and drink of the goodness of the Lord. Wisdom personifies the extravagant love which God freely offers to all people. She builds a house which rivals Solomon's great Temple. To that house, Wisdom invites those who are simple, those who lack understanding, to a feast. She beckons them to come, eat, and drink of God's love and advance in the way of understanding. Wisdom contrasts the banquet of God with the banquet of foolishness. Whereas intimacy with God brings life and understanding, foolishness brings nothing of any lasting value. We can clearly see the connection of the Old Testament promise of intimacy with God with its fulfillment in today's Gospel. Jesus is the divine food and drink which is given to us to share.

Paul advises the Ephesians to pursue the things of God and avoid the behavior of foolish people. While belief in the teachings of Jesus is essential, more than that is demanded of His disciples. Watch how you live is Paul's admonition. He teaches that faith and action go hand in hand. One does not suffice without the other. To achieve understanding and wisdom, Paul advises: be filled with the Spirit, sing and play to the Lord in your hearts, and give thanks to God. In contrast, Paul names ignorance, foolishness, drunkenness, and debauchery as behaviors to avoid. He contrasts life from God with foolishness from human nature, and invites the Ephesians to choose the way of wisdom.

Today's Gospel deepens our understanding of the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes which we heard three weeks ago. Jesus revealed Himself to the disciples as the Bread of Life. This image conveyed the deeper message that Jesus was sent by God as the means to eternal life, and also prefigured the Eucharist as the continuation of the presence of Jesus in the world.

The Gospel message today is intended for us today. The Lord addresses an invitation to us, urging us to receive Him in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. This is an invitation to us to come to the altar and eat and drink of the body and blood of Jesus. Our presence and participation in the Eucharistic liturgy are signs of our willingness to accept the invitation of Jesus to be one with Him and the Father. Our actions toward our neighbor give witness to the fact that we believe the Bread of Life we eat is Jesus, who gave Himself for the life of the world. We need to strive, every day of our lives, to taste and see the goodness of the Lord.



First Reading: Proverbs 9:1-6 A rich woman invites many guests to her home to eat and drink. She appeals to those who lack understanding to forsake foolishness and "advance in the way of understanding."

Psalm: 34:2-3,4-5,6-7 A prayer of praise to God for His goodness



Second Reading: Ephesians 5:15-20 Paul advises the Ephesians to abandon foolish ways and evil deeds. All Christians should concentrate on doing God's will before all other things. He reminds them to always give thanks to God in the name of Jesus Christ.

Gospel: John 6:51-58 Jesus had just told the crowd that anyone who ate of the bread He planned to give would live forever, and that this bread was His flesh, which He would give up for the sake of the world. The people do not understand, but Jesus reassures them that His flesh is real food and that "those who feed on this bread shall live forever."



Family Connection

Our faith teaches us that when we gather to celebrate the Eucharist, Jesus Himself is present to us. Through the actions of the Mass, the bread and wine truly become the Body and Blood of Christ. This is what we mean by the word transubstantiation. Jesus makes Himself present to all who receive the Body and Blood of Christ.

If there are children in your family who have already celebrated their First Communion, invite them to share their memories of this special day. If you have family photos from this occasion, bring them out and share them. Adults in the family may also share memories or photos of their First Communion. Then read together today's Gospel, John 6:51-58. Reflect together on what Jesus means when He calls himself the "living bread." Recall that every time we receive the Eucharist, Jesus keeps the promise He made in today's Gospel. Perhaps family members can share what it means for them to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. Together, thank God for this gift of Holy Communion. Pray together the Lord's Prayer or today's psalm



BAPTISM INSTRUCTION SESSIONS: Parents and Godparents must attend **Pre-Jordan Sacramental Preparation** before the Baptism takes place. Prior to attendance, *parents are required to pre-register those attending the session by contacting the Parish Center Office*, 215-855-1311.

Although instruction sessions are mandatory for both Parents and Godparents, you are required to attend one time only. If you have attended previously you are not required to come again. Ideally, attendance at the preparation session should occur before the child's birth. Upcoming sessions are scheduled in the RE Room (in the church), at 7:00 PM on the 3rd Monday of the month: August 20th, September 17th.

REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS

- → must be a registered member of a Catholic Parish and receive a Certificate of Eligibility from that Parish and have attended the Pre-Jordan Baptism class
- \rightarrow must have completed his/her 16th birthday
- → must have been Baptized Confirmed and has received First Holy Communion - and actively practicing their faith - e.g., attending Mass, receiving Holy Communion - receiving the Sacrament of Penance
- \rightarrow if married must be living in a valid sacramental marriage
- \rightarrow cannot be the parent of the child to be baptized
- → the godparents are to be one male and one female
 → one godparent may be a non-Catholic Christian witness with proper proof of his/her baptism if a non-Catholic is asked to be a Christian witness the other godparent MUST be Catholic
- \rightarrow a person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason, may not be asked to carry out this responsibility

Please note: The paperwork for the child's baptism and certificates of eligibility MUST be completed at least two weeks prior to scheduling a baptism date. Certificates of eligibility must have a parish seal and cannot be faxed; they must be the original.

Baptism is administered at **12:30PM Every Sunday**.


