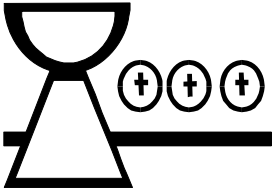
Mission Statement for the Parish of Corpus Christi

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

In the closing prayer of last Sunday's Mass we prayed, "Almighty God, may the love of Christ touch our lives and lead us to You." Just touch our lives? Only occasionally influence our lives? Is that what we asked for last Sunday? The opening prayer of today's Mass makes clear what "touching our lives" should mean to us, for in it we pray, "Lord, make Your love the foundation of our lives." These eight words ask that God's love for us, and our love for Him, might become the basis, the reason, the motive of all our thoughts, words, and actions – of all our dealings with God and our neighbor.

We do think and speak and act from many different motives, for many different reasons, under many different influences. We can pray out of habit, without much attention, with deliberate distractions, and thus deserve a reproach such as, "This people honors Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me."

We can see, and resent, the troubles, misfortunes, and burdens of life. We can see them as caused by the wickedness or selfishness of others, or as the result of blind chance, forgetting that all followers of Christ are invited to take up and carry crosses daily, and thus truly walk in His steps.

Even our good deeds, our praiseworthy activities, can be done out of human respect, out of fear of criticism, out of feelings of guilt, out of a desire for praise, or even out of sheer laziness, because it is not worth risking anger or argument by acting otherwise.


What does Saint Paul, inspired by the Holy Spirit, say of such deeds, done out of such motives? To the people of Corinth he wrote, "If I speak in human and angelic tongues, but do not have love, I am a resounding gong or a clashing cymbal. And if I have the gift of prophecy and comprehend all mysteries and all knowledge; if I have all faith so as to move mountains but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give away everything I own, and if I hand my body over so that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing."

He is saying that all our actions if not sinful, are at least useless, wasted, without merit, if somehow, in some way, they are not motivated by love of God. He is echoing and applying to daily life the first and greatest commandment: "Therefore, you shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength."

Jesus Himself has said, "Whoever has My commandments and observes them is the one who loves Me. And whoever loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and reveal Myself to him."

When is God's love for us, and our love for Him, the foundation of our lives? When we keep His commandments.

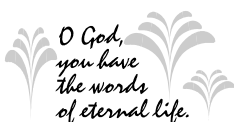

First Reading: 2 Kings 5:14-17 Elisha cures Naaman of leprosy, which convinces Naaman that there is only one God. Naaman then asks to take some loads of soil from Israel, so that he can worship and make sacrifices to one true God on his own land.

Responsorial Psalm: PS 98:1, 2-3, 3-4
R. (cf. 2b) The Lord has revealed to the nations His saving power.

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 2:8-13 Paul reminds Timothy that Christ rose from the dead so that many people could be saved. Paul was being treated as a criminal and kept in chains but says, "There is no chaining the word of God!" Paul also says, "if we die in Christ, we will live in Him. But if we deny Him, He will deny us."

Gospel: Luke 17:11-19 Jesus cures ten lepers, but only one returns to express gratitude for being healed. Jesus is disappointed that only one gave thanks to God, but tells that one, "Your faith has been your salvation."

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

"They stood at a distance from Him and raised their voices, saying, 'JESUS, MASTER! Have pity on us!' And when He saw them He said, 'Go show yourselves to the priests.'... 'Has none returned but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?' Then He said to him, 'Stand up and go, your faith has saved you.'"

A familiar gospel passage, usually attached to our celebration of Thanksgiving. Nine did what they were told to do, don't chastise them for that. One had a deeper insight to what happened, and he was praised and came back to Jesus.

As we soon will bring the Jubilee Year of Mercy to a close we, like the ten, call out 'have pity on us.' Why not take the seven works of mercy and put a name or face on them, as we find leprosy and hurt in those around us. 'Jesus Master', help me feed the hungry, support a shelter.

Help me ease the thirst of someone. Assist me in giving some good clothing to a needy person. May we cry for the refugees and welcome the immigrant in our community. Allow me the privilege of praying for an incarcerated person, or lift this or another family's burden. A phone call to an elderly shut in, or a card to a person in rehab makes Jesus' compassion present. He didn't even touch the leper, but spiritually reached out to him.

Simple things, but expressions of compassion, mercy, making Christ present to those whom Pope Francis calls the marginalized.

BAPTISM INSTRUCTION SESSIONS: Parents and Godparents must attend **Pre-Jordan Sacramental Preparation** before the Baptism takes place. Prior to attendance, **parents are requested to pre-register for the session by contacting the Parish Center Office 215-855-1311.**

Although instruction sessions are mandatory for both Parents and Godparents, you are required to attend one time only. If you have attended previously you are not required to come again. Ideally, attendance at the preparation session should occur before the child's birth. Upcoming sessions are scheduled in the **RE Room (in the church), at 7:00 PM on the 3rd Monday of the month i.e. October 17th, November 21st.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS

- must be a registered member of a Catholic Parish and receive a Certificate of Eligibility from that Parish and have attended the Pre-Jordan Baptism class
- must have completed his/her 16th birthday
- must have been Baptized - Confirmed - and has received First Holy Communion --- and actively practicing their faith - e.g., attending Mass, receiving Holy Communion - receiving the Sacrament of Penance
- if married - must be living in a valid sacramental marriage
- cannot be the parent of the child to be baptized
- the godparents are to be one male and one female
- one godparent may be a non-Catholic Christian witness with proper proof of his/her baptism — if a non-Catholic is asked to be a Christian witness - the other godparent **MUST** be Catholic
- a person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason, may not be asked to carry out this responsibility

Please note: **The paperwork for the child's baptism and certificates of eligibility* MUST be completed at least two weeks prior to scheduling a baptism date.** Certificates of eligibility must have a parish seal and cannot be faxed; they must be the original.

****CERTIFICATES OF ELIGIBILITY:** A certificate of eligibility is asking for a priest to sign and acknowledge that the person is 16 years of age or more, confirmed (and if married marriage took place in the Catholic Church) and celebrating the sacraments regularly. Ideally, this person should be registered and an active member of the parish for at least six (6) months

Baptism is administered at **12:30 PM almost EVERY SUNDAY.**
