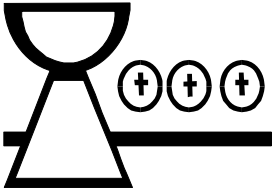

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

Opportunity is the key word for understanding today's readings. We hear from the book of Wisdom how the Lord affords us the opportunity to have our sins overlooked so that we may repent, for the Lord loves all things that are, and loathes nothing that He has made. Saint Paul reminds us, in the second reading that we have the opportunity to glorify the name of the Lord Jesus in us and we in Him through our living just and upright lives of faith and good works.

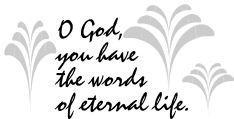

The gospel today provides a heightened example of opportunity for Zacchaeus, the tax collector. Through his persistence and determination, Zacchaeus climbed a tree to afford himself the chance to see Jesus or possibly have the opportunity to encounter Him. Jesus was aware of the desire of Zacchaeus to see Him.

Zacchaeus was very well known among the people, but they had little respect for him. Some even avoided and despised him because of his wealth, which they regarded as ill-gotten. People saw Zacchaeus as a lost sinner or poor soul who, because of the way he gained his wealth, was not pleasing to God. So, opportunity knocked when Jesus practically invited Himself to dine with Zacchaeus. The crowd gossiped and grumbled. How dare Jesus eat with a sinner!

Zacchaeus repented of his sins and promised to share his wealth with the poor and to pay back fourfold those from whom he had extorted money for taxes. He does these things in spite of the grumbling and verbal abuse that was heaped on him. Zacchaeus seized the moment when it was offered to him and took the opportunity to listen to Jesus and then straighten out his life. His response was pleasing to Jesus.

We are given many opportunities by God to straighten up our lives. Unlike Zacchaeus, we may not be as determined to do so, and then we will be the ones to lose out in the end. Our human nature invites us to procrastinate and not want to change our ways. When we gather around the table of the Lord, preparing to receive the Bread of Life, we must seize the moment and look at ourselves honestly and sincerely. Can we recognize the opportunity that the Lord is providing for each of us? The Lord has invited us to come to His table. Be prepared to partake in His love.

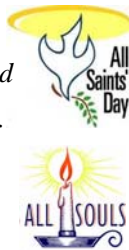

First Reading: Wisdom 11:22—12:2 In this reading, we are reminded of the love God feels toward every creature, or else He would not have created them. God shows mercy on our sins and hopes we will repent and have faith in Him.

Responsorial Psalm: PS 145:1-2, 8-9, 10-11, 13, 14
R. (cf. 1) I will praise Your name for ever, my king and my God.

Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 1:11—2:2 Paul tells the Thessalonians that God will make them worthy of His call, so that they can be glorified in Christ. Paul also tells them he is unsure when Christ will come again, but urges them not to believe people who falsely state that Jesus has returned.

Gospel: Luke 19:1-10 Zacchaeus, the wealthy chief tax collector in Jericho, was very excited when Jesus came to town and asked to stay with him. People were angry that Jesus would go to a sinner's home. Zacchaeus then told Jesus he planned to give half of his belongings to the poor, and repay any person he had cheated. Jesus was delighted since His mission was "to search out and save what was lost."

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

"When he reached the place, Jesus looked up and said, 'Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house.' And he came down quickly and received him with joy..."

"For the Son of Man has come to seek and save what was lost..." "But You have mercy on all, because You can do all things, and You overlook people's sins that they may repent. For You love all things that are, and loathe nothing that You have made."

The tree climbing Zacchaeus went out of his way to see Jesus. How surprised he must have been, when after seeing him, Jesus invited Himself to visit his home. We can easily form a picture of the event, the first scene at the tree, the second dining at Zacchaeus' home as we overhear the conversation, the murmuring and humble confession.

We too, seek Jesus, and sometimes don't know where He is in our life. Look up, look around, look for Him in our church tabernacles. Don't you see?

Jesus is always seeking us, is present to us, asking us to bring to Him what we have and who we are. We are His brothers and sisters, and sit at table with Him both in our homes as well as at worship at mass.

He knows us as we are, and yet wants to sit with us, calling, healing and making us holy.

BAPTISM INSTRUCTION SESSIONS: Parents and Godparents must attend **Pre-Jordan Sacramental Preparation** before the Baptism takes place. Prior to attendance, *parents are requested to pre-register for the session by contacting the Parish Center Office 215-855-1311.*

Although instruction sessions are mandatory for both Parents and Godparents, you are required to attend one time only. If you have attended previously you are not required to come again. Ideally, attendance at the preparation session should occur before the child's birth. Upcoming sessions are scheduled in the **RE Room (in the church), at 7:00 PM on the 3rd Monday of the month i.e. November 21st, December 19th.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS

- must be a registered member of a Catholic Parish and receive a Certificate of Eligibility from that Parish and have attended the Pre-Jordan Baptism class
- must have completed his/her 16th birthday
- must have been Baptized - Confirmed - and has received First Holy Communion --- and actively practicing their faith - e.g., attending Mass, receiving Holy Communion - receiving the Sacrament of Penance
- if married - must be living in a valid sacramental marriage
- cannot be the parent of the child to be baptized
- the godparents are to be one male and one female
- one godparent may be a non-Catholic Christian witness with proper proof of his/her baptism — if a non-Catholic is asked to be a Christian witness - the other godparent **MUST** be Catholic
- a person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason, may not be asked to carry out this responsibility

Please note: **The paperwork for the child's baptism and certificates of eligibility* MUST be completed at least two weeks prior to scheduling a baptism date.** Certificates of eligibility must have a parish seal and cannot be faxed; they must be the original.

****CERTIFICATES OF ELIGIBILITY:** *A certificate of eligibility is asking for a priest to sign and acknowledge that the person is 16 years of age or more, confirmed (and if married marriage took place in the Catholic Church) and celebrating the sacraments regularly. Ideally, this person should be registered and an active member of the parish for at least six (6) months*

Baptism is administered at **12:30 PM almost EVERY SUNDAY.**

If you have moved into our parish and have not registered with us, it is important that you call the Parish Center Office (215-855-1311) and make arrangements to do so as soon as possible. Certificates of Eligibility to act as a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation, **cannot be issued** unless you are already (preferably for 6 months) registered with us. **Please be aware that young adults over 21 (25 if in college) should register separately.**
