






PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

Artists and sculptors for centuries, when depicting the crucifixion, have included in abbreviated form the inscription Pilate ordered affixed to the cross above the head of Jesus. We are accustomed to the four letters **I-N-R-I**, which are the first letters of the Latin words for "**Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews**". Saint John's account of the crucifixion notes that Pilate's inscription was printed in three languages – Hebrew, Greek, and Latin – all the languages in use at the time in the New Testament world. This is the stage setting, so to speak, for today's gospel passage.

The Savior-King is mocked three times. This was not done by the common people who had listened to Jesus' teachings and had begun to put their trust in Him. The mockery was by their leaders, by the soldiers who served under Pilate, and by a condemned criminal. We can only imagine the shock and the scandal of the common people at seeing their hoped-for Messiah being crucified like a criminal.



Each sarcastic taunt uses the verb "save". They cried out, "Let Him save Himself if He is the Messiah of God . . . If You are the king of the Jews, save Yourself . . . Save Yourself and us." Saint Luke's account of the temptations, which we heard early in the year on the first Sunday of Lent, had Satan saying to our Lord twice, "If You are the Son of God . . ." So now, like a last temptation, a voice cries, "Aren't You the Messiah? Then save Yourself and us." It is as if, in the last moments of His human life, Christ the King hears that voice again through the pleading of a helpless condemned man.

The other criminal on Calvary, given the name of Dismas in later centuries, either had or had just received the gift of faith. He addresses Christ the King by His personal name, Jesus, which means, "savior". He quietly asks just to be remembered. "Remember me when You come into Your kingdom." The quiet answer of Jesus was unbelievably affirmative: "Today you will be with Me in Paradise."

So our final reading from Saint Luke at the end of this year's liturgical cycle of readings leaves a lasting picture of the Christ he has tried to portray for us throughout his gospel. In the second chapter of his gospel, the Savior-King was first announced to some pretty rough looking shepherds, the lowest class of workers in Palestinian society. The Savior-King is finally recognized by a condemned criminal as Jesus nears His dying breath. This tells us the kind of company this Savior-King keeps. He accepts all of us just as we are, asking only and simply, "Come follow Me." The **I-N-R-I** above His head in Hebrew, Greek, and Latin means that He is King of all peoples regardless of race, nation or status.

Next week begins the season of Advent, and we will begin all over again to adore, celebrate, and listen to the words of Christ the King, Son of God, and our Savior.

First Reading: *2 Samuel 5:1-3* Samuel describes how all the tribes of Israel went to David in Hebron and said they were his bone and his flesh and it was he who led them back to Israel. The Lord told David he would be a shepherd to His people. David made an agreement with the elders and was anointed king.

Responsorial Psalm: *PS 122:1-2, 3-4, 4-5*
R. (cf. 1) Let us go rejoicing to the house of the Lord.

Second Reading: *Colossians 1:12-20* Paul explains to the Colossians that God has made them fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light and that through the Son we have redemption and forgiveness of sin. He describes Jesus as the image of the invisible God, the head of the church and in Him all things hold together.



Gospel: *Luke 23:35-43* Jesus is mocked by the crowd as He hung on the cross. Above Him was an inscription that read "This is the king of the Jews." One of the men being crucified with Jesus tells Him to save them and Himself, while the other asks that he be remembered when Jesus is in His kingdom. Jesus said in reply, "Amen I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."


HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

"Have you no fear of God, for you are subject to the same condemnation! And indeed, we have been condemned justly, for the sentence we received corresponds to our crimes but this man has done nothing criminal." Then he said, 'Jesus remember me when You come into Your kingdom.' He replied to him, 'Amen, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise.'"

Almost daily, the media offers us stories of crimes, criminals, trials and sentencing. Shame, humiliation, and despair wound families of both victims and the accused.

How different it was on Calvary that afternoon, when the 'good thief' acknowledged guilt, expressed remorse, and won his place in heaven. Bishop Sheen stated 'He committed another crime as he stole heaven.'

Pope Francis tells the story of a person to be executed who did not repent of his deeds, and if he had the chance, he would continue to do the same wrong. The confessor asked 'Are you sorry then that you are not sorry?' May we allow the words of the repentant thief fall from our lips: 'Jesus remember me...' The year of mercy has repeated these stories over and over again.

BAPTISM INSTRUCTION SESSIONS: Parents and Godparents must attend **Pre-Jordan Sacramental Preparation** before the Baptism takes place. Prior to attendance, *parents are required to pre-register those attending the session by contacting the Parish Center Office 215-855-1311*. Although instruction sessions are mandatory for both Parents and Godparents, you are required to attend one time only. If you have attended previously you are not required to come again. Ideally, attendance at the preparation session should occur before the child's birth. Upcoming sessions are scheduled **at 7:00 PM RE Room (in the church) on the 3rd Monday of the month i.e November 21st, December 19th.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS

- must be a registered member of a Catholic Parish and receive a Certificate of Eligibility from that Parish and have attended the Pre-Jordan Baptism class
- must have completed his/her 16th birthday
- must have been Baptized - Confirmed - received First Holy Communion - and *actively* practicing their faith - e.g., attending Mass, receiving Holy Communion - receiving the Sacrament of Penance
- if married - must be living in a valid sacramental marriage
- cannot be the parent of the child to be baptized
- the godparents are to be one male and one female
- one godparent may be a non-Catholic Christian witness with proper proof of his/her baptism — if a non-Catholic is asked to be a Christian witness - the other godparent MUST be Catholic
- a person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason, may not be asked to carry out this responsibility

Please note: The paperwork for the child's baptism and certificates of eligibility* MUST be completed at least two weeks prior to scheduling a baptism date. Certificates of eligibility must have a parish seal and cannot be faxed; they must be the original.

****CERTIFICATES OF ELIGIBILITY:** *A certificate of eligibility is asking for a priest to sign and acknowledge that the person is 16 years of age or more, confirmed (and if married marriage took place in the Catholic Church) and celebrating the sacraments regularly. Ideally, this person should be registered and an active member of the parish for at least six (6) months.*

Baptism is administered at 12:30 PM almost **EVERY SUNDAY**.

Confessions: Saturday after 7:15AM Mass 3:15PM – 4:00PM, and also upon request at the Parish House.

PRAYER GROUP: to which ALL are invited meets on Thursday evenings in the Church Chapel at 8PM.

DAILY PRAYER CHAPEL OPEN: Visits to the Blessed Sacrament during the day may be made in the Church Chapel. The Chapel is open every day from 7:45AM to 3:30PM except Wednesday when it is open until 6:30PM. Please enter the Chapel using the entrance walk on the side of the Parish House facing Supplee Road.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION WEDNESDAYS

Eucharistic Adoration is scheduled every **Wednesday, from 7:45 AM til 6:30 PM** in the Church Chapel. Benediction is at 6:30 PM. (Novena devotions immediately following).
