PASTOR'S MESSAGE



Dear Parishioners,

Have you ever wondered why the disciples did not recognize the Risen Jesus when He visited them in the Upper Room? Today's gospel reading records that they did not recognize Him, in fact "in their panic and fright, they thought they were seeing a ghost." The question then is legitimate: Why didn't they recognize Jesus? The disciples didn't recognize the Risen Jesus because in His new and risen body He did not fit their expectations. He didn't match their idea of who He should be or of what He should look like.

Do we recognize Jesus as He comes to us? Or, do we fail to recognize Him for precisely the same reason as the disciples? Jesus doesn't fit our expectations. He doesn't match our preconceived ideas. Jesus truly lives now as the Risen Christ. Saint Peter clearly affirms this in today's first reading: "You put to death the Author of life but God raised Him from the dead, and we are His witnesses." Our expectations do not affect His being truly alive, but they do affect whether we recognize Him or not. Some examples will help to illustrate this point.

Do we recognize the Risen Living Christ in the Eucharist? As we celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist and especially as we move forward to receive Jesus in Holy Communion, do we recognize Him under the signs of bread and wine? Prior to the Second Vatican Council, there may have been a tendency among some to so emphasize the consecration at Mass that it seemed to be the only important moment. Prior to the Second Vatican Council, many probably did not appreciate how important the entire Mass is, not just some parts. But, in our attempt to gain a

balanced perspective, we must not forget the fact that we believe that beneath the signs of bread and wine there is present the Real Jesus, the Risen Jesus, the Jesus Who lives now and forever.

Does our attitude in celebrating the Liturgy and in coming forward to receive Holy Communion reflect this belief? Does our behavior after Communion indicate that we believe that Jesus is now with us, yes, within us? Do we always make a proper thanksgiving after receiving? Jesus and each one of us, Jesus and all of us who gather at Mass, have just become one. Do we recognize Jesus beneath the signs? If we do not expect Him to be present, we will not recognize Him. What a tragedy! What a loss for us!

Do we recognize the risen Living Jesus in the words of scripture proclaimed in the Liturgy of the Word? What is proclaimed to us is not just history or ordinary words; what is proclaimed to us is God's Word! God is speaking to us! Do we listen attentively? Do we search out the meaning of God's message for us? Do we recognize God through His word? If we do not expect God to be present, we will not recognize Him. What a tragedy! What a loss for us! Do we recognize the Risen Living Jesus in each other? Whenever we gather in twos, threes, or more, the Lord is present among us. That is His promise to us. If we do not expect Christ to be present in one another, in the community called family or Church, we will not recognize Him. What a tragedy! What a loss for us!

Before we criticize the first disciples too harshly for their lack of recognition, we best look to ourselves and ask, "How do we expect Jesus to come among us?" Let us learn that Jesus comes in many ways and let us recognize Him through faith whenever and however He chooses to come to us.

First Reading: Acts 3:13-15, 17-19 Peter reminds the people that they allowed Jesus to be killed, and preferred to allow a murderer to be released. But God raised Him from the dead as had been prophesied. Therefore, all people should believe and turn to God, that their sins might be forgiven.

Responsorial Psalm: PS 4:2, 4, 7-8, 9 *Lord, let Your face shine on us.*

Second Reading: I John 2:1-5a Jesus was offered up for the sins of the world. The only way to prove true faith in Him, is to honor His commandments. Anyone who claims to believe, yet does not keep His word, does not truly believe.



Gospel: Luke 24:35-48 Jesus appeared to two disciples, though at first they feared He was a ghost. Jesus ate with them to prove He was not a ghost. He explained that He had fulfilled the prophets words about Him. He also explained that in His name they must preach doing penance for the forgiveness of sins.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

“Now I know brothers that you acted out of ignorance, just as your leaders did. But God has thus brought to fulfillment what He had announced beforehand that through the mouth of all the prophets that His Christ would suffer. Repent, therefore and be converted that your sins may be wiped away... Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures... Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer, and rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins would be preached in His name to all the nations.”

The wonderful sermon of Saint Peter offers encouragement, not judgment, summoning his hearers to listen more closely. The scriptures they knew, the prophets and psalms, pointed to the events which had taken place in Jerusalem. As they listened, they were able to conclude ‘this makes sense, I’ll follow what he says and begin living as a witness.’

Twenty centuries have passed, the sermon of Peter is repeated for my benefit as he opens our minds and hearts. If these words changed the hearts of his listeners, what is happening in my heart at this moment? Am I, or am I not a witness?

A deacon's ministry entails proclaiming, preaching and teaching God's Word, assisting the bishop and priest at the Liturgy, assisting at funerals, ministering to the sick and dying, leading the community in prayer and in sacramental liturgies, baptizing, witnessing marriages, and exercising administrative leadership in the Church. A permanent deacon, who may be married, is a member of the clergy and shares in the hierarchy of the Sacrament of Holy Orders. Through the Sacrament of Holy Orders, the deacon is configured to Christ the Servant. It is Christ the Servant who acts through the ministry of the deacon.

Cougar Non-Contact Passing League and Lineman Clinic
The Cougar Passing League and Lineman Clinic is designed to teach the fundamentals of football for players of all experience levels. Players will work skill development at the skill positions – Quarterback, Running back, Receiver, Tight End, Linebacker and Defensive back –and for the Offensive/Defensive Lineman. The sessions are designed to teach each player position-specific techniques working 1-on-1 and in small groups, and to apply those skills in a fun, round robin 7-on-7 (two-hand touch) competition at every session. BAPTISM INSTRUCTION SESSIONS: Parents and Godparents must attend **Pre-Jordan Sacramental Preparation** before the Baptism takes place. Prior to attendance, *parents are required to pre-register those attending the session by contacting the Parish Center Office 215-855-1311.* Although instruction sessions are mandatory for both Parents and Godparents, you are required to attend one time only. If you have attended previously you are not required to come again. Ideally, attendance at the preparation session should occur before the child's birth. Upcoming sessions are scheduled at **7:00 PM RE Room (in the church) on the 3rd Monday of the month i.e. April 16th, May 21st.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS

- must be a registered member of a Catholic Parish and receive a Certificate of Eligibility from that Parish and have attended the Pre-Jordan Baptism class
- must have completed his/her 16th birthday
- must have been Baptized - Confirmed - received First Holy Communion - and *actively* practicing their faith - e.g., attending Mass, receiving Holy Communion - receiving the Sacrament of Penance
- if married - must be living in a valid sacramental marriage
- cannot be the parent of the child to be baptized
- the godparents are to be one male and one female
- one godparent may be a non-Catholic Christian witness with proper proof of his/her baptism — if a non-Catholic is asked to be a Christian witness - the other godparent **MUST** be Catholic
- a person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason, may not be asked to carry out this responsibility

Please note: The paperwork for the child's baptism and certificates of eligibility* **MUST** be completed at least two weeks prior to scheduling a baptism date. Certificates of eligibility must have a parish seal and cannot be faxed; they must be the original.

****CERTIFICATES OF ELIGIBILITY:** A certificate of eligibility is asking for a priest to sign and acknowledge that the person is 16 years of age or more, confirmed (and if married marriage took place in the Catholic Church) and celebrating the sacraments regularly. Ideally, this person should be registered and an active member of the parish for at least six (6) months.

Baptism is administered at 12:30 PM almost EVERY SUNDAY.

Confessions: Saturday after 7:15AM Mass 3:15PM – 4:00PM, and also upon request at the Parish House.

DAILY PRAYER CHAPEL OPEN: Visits to the Blessed Sacrament during the day may be made in the Church Chapel. The Chapel is open every day from 7:45AM to 3:30PM except Wednesday when it is open until 6:30PM. Please enter the Chapel using the entrance walk on the side of the Parish House facing Supplee Road.
