



PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

Today's reading from the prophet Zechariah says, "The warrior's bow shall be banished, and He (the Savior) shall proclaim peace to the nations." In the Old Testament, we hear of anointed kings doing battle with their enemies. Peace is brought about by the military defeat of one's enemies. As the scriptures unfold, the prophets reveal the idea that true peace is not brought about by the use of force and war.



True peace is found in the heart of a peaceful person. Jesus tells us that we must love our enemies and do good to those who hate us. The spiritual idea of peace is now fully separated from the military idea of peace. The emperors of Rome brought temporary peace into the world. It was, however, peace that was brought about by the defeat of one's enemies and maintained by military power and might. The civil authorities, from the time of the Greeks and the Romans to the present day, continue to believe that peace can only be maintained by the use of power.

As Christians, we stand in contradiction to the idea that peace can be brought about by the use of arms, or that peace can only be maintained by military force or the warring of nations. We stand as deviants from a popular philosophy. We probably stand alone as we proclaim the message that love of God and our neighbor will bring peace. Though this neighbor may hate us or seek to destroy our culture or our religion, this is the neighbor with whom we must share the peace of the Lord.

Matthew reminds us that it is to the humble and the peaceful that the full revelation of the Son will be made. Recall the story of the camel trying to pass through the eye of the needle, and Jesus telling the people that it is harder for a rich person to enter the kingdom of heaven. Today's gospel reminds us that it is hard, very hard, for those driven by power to know the true peace of Christ. More often than not, it is the humble and downtrodden who allow themselves to be open to the movement of grace which brings peace. These are the people who will convert the world by loving their neighbor, rather than killing their enemy. It is hard for those in power to accept that true peace can come about through a spiritual revolution. It is hard for them to surrender their riches or their power because they believe they can achieve much more through their use.

Do we issue laws in our homes and enforce them because we are more powerful than the members of our family? We cannot forget the words of Zechariah, "The warrior's bow shall be banished, and He shall proclaim peace to the nations," followed by Matthew's words in today's gospel, "Father, Lord of heaven and earth, to You I offer praise; for what You have hidden from the learned and the clever You have revealed to the merest children."

First Reading: Zechariah 9:9-10 This is a prophecy of the coming of the Messiah to Jerusalem. He will come, not as a King, but as a humble Savior, riding on an ass.

Responsorial Psalm: 145:1-2, 8-9, 10-11, 13-14 I will praise your name for ever, my king and my God.

Second Reading: Romans 8:9, 11-13 Contrasting "flesh and spirit," Paul urges that all who live for material things abandon the temptations of the flesh and rise to life in the "Spirit."

Gospel: Matthew 11:25-30 Jesus speaks lovingly and gently when He invites all those who are weary and burdened with life to seek relief and respite in Him. He says, "Your souls will find rest, for My yoke is easy and My burden light."



"If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, then He who raised Christ from the dead will bring your mortal bodies to life also through the Spirit dwelling in you..." "Come to Me you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you. Take My yoke upon your shoulders and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble of heart."

How often we are asked to give our address, or telephone number, or provide some form of identification. We are also warned sternly to protect our identity from theft. We use passwords, shredders and blocks to assure privacy and protection.

One personal question for all of us today is whether the Spirit of Jesus lives with you or not. I struggle to answer the question, but know that when I strive for holiness and live the life of grace, the Spirit of God finds His address in me. Reassured of that presence happily and boldly respond to the invitation to grow closer to Jesus.

Yes, I become weary, but the psalm tells us God does not tire, 'unweary is Your love for us.' I am constantly reminded of His steadfast love. I picture His open arms reaching out to me, especially in moments of trial or need. **'Yes', He says 'come to Me'**. He picks me up, like a cool refreshing drink on a hot afternoon. He lifts me beyond what causes me to hesitate or stumble. He invites me again. He gently places me on His shoulder to carry me home. As He does so, let His words echo in my heart **'I will refresh you.'**



BAPTISM INSTRUCTION SESSIONS: Parents and Godparents must attend **Pre-Jordan Sacramental Preparation** before the Baptism takes place. Prior to attendance, *parents are requested to pre-register for the session by contacting the Parish Center Office 215-855-1311.*

Although instruction sessions are mandatory for both Parents and Godparents, you are required to attend one time only. If you have attended previously you are not required to come again. Ideally, attendance at the preparation session should occur before the child's birth. Upcoming sessions are scheduled in the **RE Room (in the church), at 7:00 PM on the 3rd Monday of the month i.e. July 21st, or August 18th.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS

- must be a registered member of a Catholic Parish and receive a Certificate of Eligibility from that Parish and have attended the Pre-Jordan Baptism class
- must have completed his/her 16th birthday
- must have been Baptized - Confirmed - and has received First Holy Communion --- and actively practicing their faith - e.g., attending Mass, receiving Holy Communion - receiving the Sacrament of Penance
- if married - must be living in a valid sacramental marriage
- cannot be the parent of the child to be baptized
- the godparents are to be one male and one female
- one godparent may be a non-Catholic Christian witness with proper proof of his/her baptism — if a non-Catholic is asked to be a Christian witness - the other godparent **MUST** be Catholic
- a person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason, may not be asked to carry out this responsibility

Please note: **The paperwork for the child's baptism and certificates of eligibility* MUST be completed at least two weeks prior to scheduling a baptism date.** Certificates of eligibility must have a parish seal and cannot be faxed; they must be the original.

***CERTIFICATES OF ELIGIBILITY:** *A certificate of eligibility is asking for a priest to sign and acknowledge that the person is 16 years of age or more, confirmed and married in the Catholic Church and celebrating the sacraments regularly. Ideally, this person should be registered and an active member of the parish for at least six (6) months.*

Baptism is administered at **12:30 PM EVERY SUNDAY.**
