



It's said that the long term memory is better than the short term, so this reminiscence will focus on our early years. The 60's marked significant visible changes in the Church, especially the Liturgy with the Priest facing us, Lay Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and so on. For a core group of us it also meant starting out as a new-parish to be built from next to nothing. Moving from our parent parishes was traumatic for some, but the challenging pilgrimage proved more of an adventure than we could have imagined.

Centered around an wid farm house and under the leadership of Fr. John Doyle, we were a nomadic group of Catholics for a while, worshiping in a barn, a motel banquet hall and an wid one-room school house. In a little over a year we would settle into a permanent home and truly be recognized as Corpus Christi Parish. A school, social hall, convent and the foundation of a church did much to inspire us and ease the growing pains.

Evident through this process was our very own "father figure", Pastor Doyle, usually accompanied by his faithful Dalmatian, "Lady". Though at times rather strict, insisting the ladies wear head coverings in church, he also had a gentle side, anointing my father, or greasing the gears as he said, on several occasions throughout his illness. In his later years, Father would sit outside church in good weather, in his beret, leaning on his cane and greet his parishioners.

The founding members were ever a part of the growing spirit that marked our uniqueness as a parish. The many long summers were survived with the help of numerous fans in the church, and recollecting one early Christmas snow storm, the telephone committee circulated to all parish members the revised Mass schedule for the day after some of the snow had been cleared. The bake sales, bazaars, the Ladies of Corpus Christi, the Holy Name Society, our famous Bingo, a real survivor through the years, and much more, bring back not only fond memories of events, but also a rersembrance of the comradery that developed along the way.

Corpus Christi has never been static, but always growing and developing. Succeeding Fr. Doyle, Fr. Frank Loughran continued this founding spirit. Father provided not only the spiritual and physical leadership but also was most visible as a helping-hand on many occasions. Through the efforts of Fr. Loughran and currently, Msgr. Thomas Flanigan, additional construction has provided more educational and meeting space, a gym/auditorium and finally the grand eclifice of our permanent Church. Parish membership has dramatically increased over the years along with the many organizations, committees, and programs too sumerous to mention. All this makes for the continued vibrancy lingering from those founding families. There are certainly many additional thoughts to be gleaned from my fellow "old timers", but the more recent memories are for the next generation of parishioners to document.

OUR HISTORY.



In April 1964, the Archdiocese of Philadelphia purchased fifty-six acres of land in Upper Gwynedd, known as the John Curtin Farm, and on May 22nd issued the decree establishing a new parish to be situated on this land. His Eminence, John Cardinal Krol, appointed Rev. John E. Doyle as the first Pastor of the parish to be known as Corpus Christi — the Body of Christ.


Early in 1965, the Archdiocese gave Father Doyle authority to spend \$460,000 for Church and School buildings. The school

building was the first to be completed and opened on September 8th with 220 children present. Four Sisters of Saint Joseph staffed the new school under the guidance of Mother Marie Margaret, the principal. The school hall was then able to be used for Sunday Masses.



Ground breaking for the parish building was held on February 14th, 1965. The design was formulated to meet present and future requirements of the parish and to conform to the residential character of the community.


Many of our parish organizations were started — the Holy Name Society, Ushers and Altar Committee, Ladies of Corpus Christi, the Home and School Association, and the Athletic Association. The parishioners were generous with time, talent, and financial help to support the parish.



In June 1981, Father Doyle retired from active duty and was appointed Pastor Emeritus and Father Francis J. Loughran was assigned as our new Pastor.

Because of the growth of the parish, it was necessary to expand the school as well as the parish facilities. Funded by pledges from generous parishioners of approximately \$800,000, the parish added new classrooms, meeting rooms, library, and kindergarten. A large gymnasium was included with a stage, which is used for many church and school functions. The new addition was dedicated in December 1984.





In January 1985, Father Loughran retired from active leadership and was appointed Pastor Emeritus. Father Thomas P. Flanigan was assigned as our new Pastor.

Over the years, Corpus Christi has grown from 350 families to over 3,750 families and continues to grow.



In 1995, the parish had completed a self-study and developed an action plan. Our goals were to build Christian Community, to teach our faith to all ages, and to bring everyone to meaningful worship. The parish also had a Development Plan which included the construction of a new Church, the establishment of a Youth Center and a Social Center, and the expansion of the school.



In October 1997, a Capital Campaign was initiated to raise two million dollars for a new church. Groundbreaking took place in September 1998. Because of the wonderful generosity of the people, the church was completed in December 1999 and was dedicated by Cardinal Bevilacqua on January 15, 2000. The parish of Corpus Christi has the distinction of having the first new church in the Archdiocese in Jubilee Year 2000, the new millennium of Christianity.





Construction started in January 2006 for the expansion of our new Parish Education and Office Center. The first floor consists of three new meeting rooms and a conference room, and is home to our administrative offices and parish business operations. The second floor is where our upper grades (6-8) are situated. Construction was completed in the spring of 2007, and occupancy took place over the summer of 2007.

The parish continues to grow with many talented and involved parishioners participating in the numerous programs. With ongoing prayer of praise and thanks to God, we are striving to live out in our homes and in the community the three parish goals mentioned above. Under the leadership of Monsignor Flanigan, the other priests, religious sisters, and dedicated laity, we continue to build the Body of Christ — Corpus Christi.
